On June 13, 1892, the Charter of the **Lycoming County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals** was approved for incorporation. The Lycoming County SPCA is a 501 (c)(3) overseen by an experienced board of directors and operated by a compassionate group of staff and volunteers. Our team cares for almost 4,000 animals and investigates more than 600 cases of cruelty, abuse and neglect each year.

The **Lycoming County SPCA** is an open admission shelter caring for all types of domestic animals.

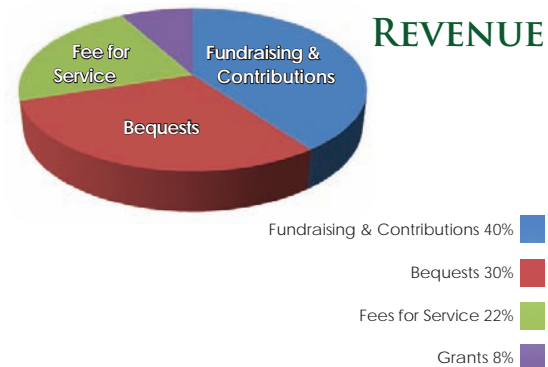
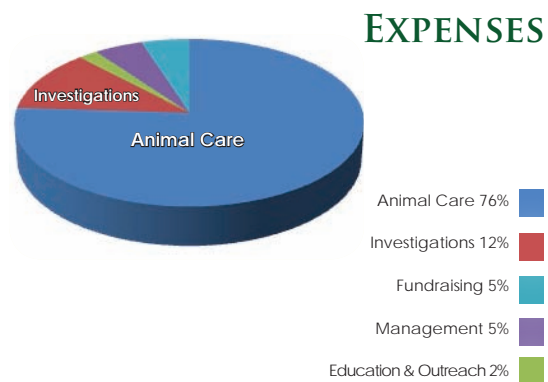
We are the only shelter in the county that cares for **all** domestic animals. Our involvement in the community is not limited to just animal care. Hundreds of hours are spent educating youth and the community about pet responsibility and dog bite prevention. We also take shelter animals to nursing homes for pet therapy visits. Financial assistance is provided to low income pet owners to have their pets spayed or neutered.
